Dear Sir/Madam,

I am writing to notify you of an unlawful claim of ownership by Universal Music Group (UMG) to one of my copyrighted works. The work is a song is called "Over and Over Again". It is a waltz arranged for a Slovenian-style polka band which I wrote, recorded, and released in 2003 on the CD album, *On the Bright Side*. According to SoundExchange, you (UMG) are claiming ownership rights to the song (SoundExchange ID #SX3101UDAZ.) As a result of your claim, the royalties I have rightfully earned from that song are being held indefinitely by SoundExchange and will not be released to me until the dispute over the song's ownership is settled.

You have received a copy of the ownership dispute from SoundExchange via an email dated June 21, 2018. A printed copy of the email is enclosed for your convenience. Please refer to that email for the details of this matter.

**I declare under the penalty of perjury that I, Tom Brusky, created the words and music to the aforementioned "Over and Over Again." I am the sole, legal copyright owner of that song, and I have never at any time sold nor relinquished my rights to it.**

You are hereby notified to immediately **CEASE AND DESIST** all claims of ownership to that song. Furthermore, you must contact SoundExchange within 10 days of the receipt of this letter to settle the song's ownership dispute by informing them that you rescind all past and present claims of ownership to the song.

If these demands are met within the stated 10-day time period, I will consider the matter resolved and take no further action. If these demands are *not* met within the stated 10-day time period, I will refer the matter to legal counsel and request they seek a temporary injunction to put an immediate stop to your claim of ownership to my song until the matter can be resolved in court. I will also defer to legal counsel to contemplate any additional remedies they may see fit to pursue.
